ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, Deekshitha Educational Development Society, Plot No. 550, Krishnapuram 2nd Road, Tadipatri Village & Post, Tadipatri Taluk, Anantapur District-515411, Andhra Pradesh had submitted an on-line application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE on 29.06.2015 and submitted printouts on 06.07.2015 for grant of recognition for B.Ed Programme of two basic units of 100 Students at Deekshitha B.Ed College, Plot No. 550, 551, 555A, Sajjaladinne Village & Post, Tadipatri Taluk, Anantapur District-515411, Andhra Pradesh

AND WHEREAS, on scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit submitted and the report received from VT and Videography, and the certificates received from the university, the Committee is satisfied that the applicant fulfils the requirements under the provisions of NCTE ACT, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the said teacher education programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, financial resources, etc., for running the programme.


- i. The Endowment fund of 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained Perpetually. Loan raising against or mortgaging of FDR's shall not be done.
 - ii. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
 - iii. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations 2014.
 - iv. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in Position.
2. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University / Body, the State Government etc, as applicable

- c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter;
 - d. Names of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
 - e. Fee charged from students;
 - f. Available infrastructural facilities;
 - g. Facilities added during the last quarter;
 - h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
 - i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
 - j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
 - k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
5. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
 6. The institution shall make available list of students admitted on its official website.

CONTINUATION ORDER

WHEREAS, recognition u/s 14 Act of NCTE, 1993 was granted to the institution namely **Deekshitha B.Ed. College, Plot No. 550, 551 & 555A, Sajjaladinne Village & Post, Tadipatri Taluk, Anantapur District, Andhra Pradesh-515411** run by **Deekshitha Educational Development Society, Anantapur District, Andhra Pradesh-515411** vide order no. F.SRO/SRCAPP14595/B.Ed./2016/83763 on 11.04.2016 for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an intake of 100 students from the academic session 2016-2017.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 388th meeting held on 14th-15th September, 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue Show Cause Notice to the institution. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 22.02.2021. The institution has submitted its reply on 11.03.2021.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 412th meeting held on 05th – 06th July, 2022 has considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice to the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 26.07.2022. The institution has submitted reply on 27.07.2022.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 413th Meeting held on 22nd & 23rd August, 2022 considered the matter and decided as follows: -

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

*The Committee on the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution **Deekshitha B.Ed. College, Survey No. 550, 551, 555A, Sajjaladinne Village, Tadipatri Mandal-515411, Anantapuramu District, Andhra Pradesh for B.Ed. programme for 2 basic units of 50 students each.**"*
